## Nature and Scope of Work

Under daily leadership and supervision, the position is responsible for the safe, effective instruction of swim lessons and lifeguarding at the Golden Municipal Swimming Pool as well as routine facility maintenance, public relations, and program registration.

## Primary Responsibilities

- Provide safe, fun, and organized activities for patrons of public swim lessons to deliver various levels of swim instruction to the level of training certified.
- Provide a proactive approach to preventing patron accidents and injury while on duty and report when required.
- Utilize POS software to create client accounts, process program registrations and payments as required.
- Proactively ensure an environment of mutual respect and professionalism toward fellow employees and in accordance with relevant corporate policy.
- Provide a high level of customer service to patrons while portraying a positive public relation image.
- Conduct routine preventative maintenance as required including janitorial duties.

## Secondary Responsibilities (Pending Step Level)

- Monitor and ensure completion of daily and routine programmatic, transactional, and operational duties and tasks by all co-workers.
- Attend in-service sessions and participate in swim lesson organization and oversight, special events, school group leadership duties, and program development and planning.
- Engage with the community through education outside of the facility.
- Oversee duties of other staff members.
- Provide support with staff schedule.
- Review and update various training manuals and the pool safety plan.
- Support works for the parks department.
- Perform inventory, product research and place recommendations for supply orders.
- Perform additional duties as required by the *Recreation Services Coordinator*.

## Supervision

The position reports directly to the lead hand and is supervised by the *Recreation Services Coordinator* with departmental oversight by the *Director of Recreation Services*.
